

## Moulton School and Science College

### Admissions Policy 2017-18

The school uses the following criteria when determining admissions. In the event of over-subscription, places for September 2017, and for in-year admissions, will be allocated in the following order of priority:

- i. To children in public care (“looked-after children”), and to children with Statements of Educational Need whose statements specify Moulton School.
- ii. To students who live in the linked area associated with Moulton School, i.e., Boughton, Brixworth, Scaldwell, Harlestone, Althorp, Moulton, Moulton Leys, Overstone, Pitsford, Sywell, The Bramptons, Walgrave, Hannington, Holcot and Old.
- iii. To students attending, on 31st October 2016, Moulton School’s designated contributory primary schools (i.e., Boughton, Brixworth, Harlestone, Moulton, Overstone, Pitsford, Sywell, The Bramptons and Walgrave) and continuing in attendance until the formal offer of places is made.
- iv. To students who are children of staff employed by the school in either or both of the following circumstances:
  - Where the member of staff has been employed at the MSSC for two or more years at the time at which the application for admission to MSSC is made;
  - The member of staff is recruited to fill a vacant post for which there is a demonstrable skills shortage.
- v. To students who will have an older brother or sister continuing at Moulton School in September 2017, or at the time of admission for an in-year admission.
- vi. To other students.

If the admission number is exceeded within category ii, priority will be given to those who live furthest from the nearest alternative school. If the admission number is exceeded within any other category, priority will be given to those who live closest to the school.

The total number of admissions for Year 7 in September 2017 will be 240.
